



During our daily Language Arts lessons, we will continue to focus on many concepts about print. While reading big books, mini-books, charts and poems we will discuss the spaces between words, the left to right direction that we read and write, punctuation marks, high-frequency words, and much more. It is so exciting to see the children's faces "light up" as their early reading and writing skills emerge! During our small group language arts sessions, the students will be working on spelling strategies, phonics, and word families!

We have learned all our letters and letter sounds. Please continue to practice these at home. We will continue to learn more high-frequency words in the classroom and add them to our "Word Wall" while also practice reading and writing them often. These key words are words that the children see repeatedly in many texts. Please continue to practice our Word Wall words at home.
