Social Studies/Science

In **Science**, we will begin our unit about Goldfish and Guppies! We are so excited to learn about this! We will observe the animals and report about it in our science notebook!

We will continue to explore letter sounds, rhyming, and clapping syllables which will support our reading and writing skills throughout the year.
