PARENT INVOLVEMENT GUIDELINES



Charlestown Elementary School is committed to Parental Involvement Guidelines and will work with the District in planning and implementing effective academic support programs and parent involvement programs by:

1. holding an annual meeting each fall to inform parents about their right to be involved in the development, review and improvement of the Parent Involvement Plan.
2. providing materials to help parents with their child's achievement
3. committing to communicating with and working with parents as equal partners.
4. providing opportunities for meetings such as parent-teacher conferences to occur in various formats and to permit two-way communication between home and school
5. using school-parent compacts, jointly developed with parents, to outline responsibilities of the school staff, parents, and students in striving to raise student achievement and explain how an effective home-school partnership will be developed.

Charlestown Elementary School will build strong parental involvement by:

1. communicating a description and explanation of grade level curriculum, forms of academic assessment used to measure student progress, and proficiency levels that students are expected to meet.
2. scheduling meetings at a variety of times, such as mornings and evenings, in order to maximize the opportunities for parents to participate in school-related activities.
3. participating in an annual survey to provide information to improve the effectiveness of instruction and services to participating children.
