We will work with your schedule.

To ensure consistency of experience, we kindly ask that you address the items below with the students who attend your session. Of course, students will ask questions and additional information can be shared.

- An overview of your career, related skills, and job function(s)
- Education/training level required for your position as well as your own education/training experiences
- Your employment history and journey to your current position and/or career field including your strengths and passions
- A description of a “typical” day or routine
- Other skills/talents that support success in your field
- Topics, courses, and experiences that may be useful to high school students considering your field. (Feel free to share what you would do differently if you went back to high school.)

Please feel free to bring in artifacts or additional materials. Although the format is intended to be conversational, we can make a screen and projector available if you'd like.

- Each session is 30 minutes. You can conduct one, two or three sessions in a day.
