SAFETY POSTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

DROP-OFF SAFETY (MORNING CAR LINE)

- **Responsibilities**
- Wear your safety belt properly while at your post
- Assist students safely out of the cars and into the building
- Assist Miss Griffin or Mr. Brown as needed
- Let Mr. Ellis, Mr. Salerno, or Mrs. Seaton know if an adult is not at your safety post
- Report to your classroom at **8:45** (or when instructed)

BUS LOADING AREA SAFETY (MORNING)

Responsibilities

- Wear your safety belt properly while at your post
- Assist students off the bus as needed
- Greet students as they enter the building
- Keep record of which busses have arrived
- Assist Mr. Ellis, Mr. Salerno, and Mrs. Seaton as needed

BREAKFAST MONITOR SAFETY (MORNING)

Responsibilities

- Wear your safety belt properly while at your post
- Report to the **cafeteria** when you arrive in the morning
- Help students getting breakfast through the breakfast line
- Encourage students to make healthy choices
- Remind students to clean up before they leave
- Help aides/custodians/teachers clean up

MORNING ANNOUNCEMENTS SAFETY

(MORNING)

Responsibilities

- Wear your safety belt properly while at your post
- Report to the main office by **8:50**
- Leading the school in the Pledge of Allegiance
- Read any announcements over the loudspeaker

CLASSROOM SAFETY (DISMISSAL)

Responsibilities

- Wear your safety belt properly while at your post
- Leave class at **3:35** to report to your post
- Report to your assigned teacher for dismissal
- Do not disturb or interrupt the classroom teacher
- Help students pack up and get ready for dismissal
- Escort students to buses
- Report to the card turners once your class has left
- Immediately get on your bus or report to the cafeteria if you're a pickup

CARD TURNER SAFETY (DISMISSAL)

Responsibilities

- Wear your safety belt properly while at your post
- Flip each teacher's card as the teacher walks their class out of the building
- If you see a substitute or teacher you don't recognize, ask whose class they have
- Leave class at **3:35** to report to your post

TRAFFIC CONTROL SAFETY (DISMISSAL)

Responsibilities

- Wear your safety belt properly while at your post
- Leave class at **3:35** to report to the main hallway
- Assist Mr. Jones, Mrs. Gregory and other teachers with dismissing classes to the buses

BUS LOADING AREA SAFETY (DISMISSAL)

Responsibilities

- Wear your safety belt properly while at your post
- Leave class at **3:35** to report to your post
- Hold up your assigned bus number sign
- Assist students onto the bus as needed
- Turn in your sign prior to getting onto the bus
- No socializing while on duty

RESPONSIBILITIES OF ALL SAFETIES

Responsibilities

- Serve as a leader for the students at K.D. Markley Elementary School
- Demonstrate the 6 Pillars of Character at all times

CONSEQUENCES

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- Warning
- Suspension
- Removed from the Safety Patrol Team permanently

*Consequence will reflect the violation

SAFETIES OF THE MONTH

- Announced at lunch each month
 - September to May
- Recognizes safeties who go "above and beyond" expectations
- Safeties are nominated by the KDM staff
- Wear the orange SOTM belt and badge for the month
- Picture on the library announcement board

WHEN WILL I BE A SAFETY?

- September to January **or** February to June
 - First half of the year or second half of the year
- Must apply by writing an essay about why you would make a good safety
 - Writing an essay does not automatically make you a safety
- Anyone not chosen to be a safety because of previous behavior concerns will have the chance to earn the right to be a safety in the second half of the year
- Students who truly go above and beyond have the chance to be a safety for the entire year



APPLICATION ESSAY

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- The application is on the Safety Patrol website
- Write an essay to Mr. Ellis and Mr. Salerno about **why you would make a good safety**
 - Do your best job to convince us that choosing you would be a good choice
- You may **request** a safety post
- Essays are due to Mr. Ellis or Mr. Salerno by **Wednesday, September 4**
- We'll let you know our decision by **Friday, September 6**
- Posts begin **Monday, September 9**
 - **You must sign and return your safety contract to receive your belt and begin your post**
