

Math Supplies

- One (1) Three-ring binder (1 ½ inches or 2 inches will be fine)
- Dividers – homemade is fine
- Two (2) spiral notebooks – one for notes and one for homework – both must have holes so they can be kept in the three-ring binder
- Pencils with erasers
- Highlighters or colored pencils – at least 3 colors
- A four (4) function calculator for everyday use – basic operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division
- A ruler – 6 inch or 12 inch (needs metric and standard)
- Two packs of index cards, 3 x 5, ruled
- A bookcover – homemade is fine – book socks must be big enough for the text book
- Graph Paper
- Tissues

Students should have these supplies by the end of the first week .
