

To Achieve Success in Mr. Brown's Math Class

- 1) Prepare for a successful class everyday
 - Be on time
 - Bring class supplies – spiral class notebook, spiral homework notebook, text book, pencils, pens, calculator, etc

- 2) Homework Completion
 - Complete every question
 - Check answers for every question on the website prior to the next class
 - Highlight questions that are wrong and try to fix prior to the next class
 - Goal is to have no more than 2 questions wrong on a homework assignment
 - If miss more than 2 questions see Mr. Brown for extra help immediately
 - Homework may take more than 30 minutes just for math
 - The approximately 30 minutes for math homework, does not count study time for tests and quizzes or for work you have difficulty understanding
 - Studying and extra problems are above and beyond the “normal” 30 minutes or so expected every night for math homework
 - The approximately 30 minutes is the minimum, if you are having difficulty or doing poorly you will need to do extra math above and beyond the minimum problems so you get caught up in your understanding
 - If you miss more than 2 questions, you will need to go back and complete the assignment a second time to master the material

- 3) Test Preparation
 - A minimum of 3 nights prior to the test start preparing
 - Night 1 – complete the practice test in the back of the chapter
 - Night 2 – complete the practice test in the back of the book
 - Night 3 – complete the study guide for the chapter
 - Check all answers to the practice tests and study guides on your own
 - See Mr. Brown about any mistakes or challenges on the practice tests

- 4) Homework Checks
 - Have homework notebook in order the night before the test
