<b>F</b> Fact Finders	Fact Checkers indicate info is false?			
	Other websites or sources backup your source's claims.			
	Googling the article title + fact check brought back some red flags			
<b>A</b> Authority	Publisher/Author is well known & generally considered reliable.			
	Cannot find info about Author/Publisher (no "about" page or nothing in google)			
	Google, Wiki, or Mediabiasfactcheck indicate scams, satire, untrustworthy reputations, etc			
	URL mimics a well known site, or has ".co" or misspellings			
<b>C</b> Check Details	Article refers to no reputable experts or eyewitnesses			
	!!! Headlines are Over the Top !!!!!			
	Photos seem unbelievable or suspicious			
	Info is outdated, or date not provided.			
	Has lots of popups or distracting ads, misspellings, or grammatical errors.			
	Source provides links or citations supporting their claims
