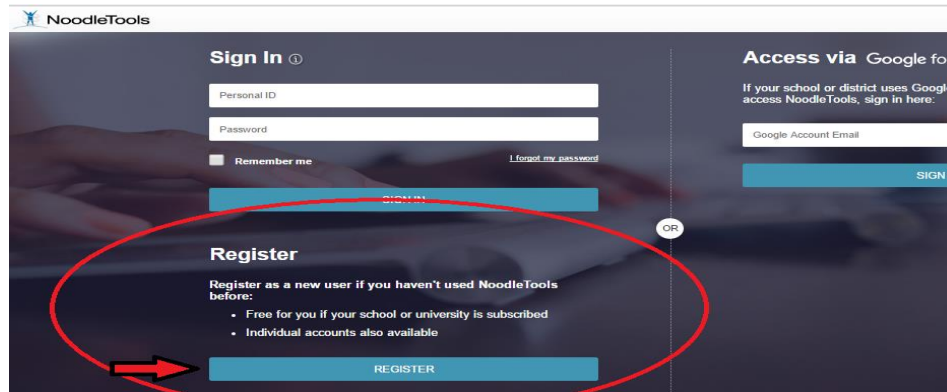


Getting Started with NoodleTools

How to Register for Noodletools

1. Go to noodletools.com
2. Scroll to the bottom of the page.
3. Click on the blue button “register.”



4. Enter the GVHS username and password
 - a. gvhs
 - b. library
5. Click “continue.”
6. Now create your own account by filling out all of the boxes.
7. Be sure to choose a username and password you will remember later. Highly suggest you save it in your phone or write it down somewhere! *
8. Click “register.”

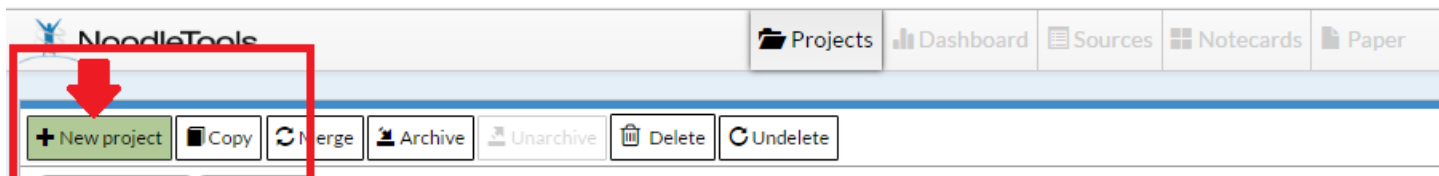

9. You now have your own Noodletools account.

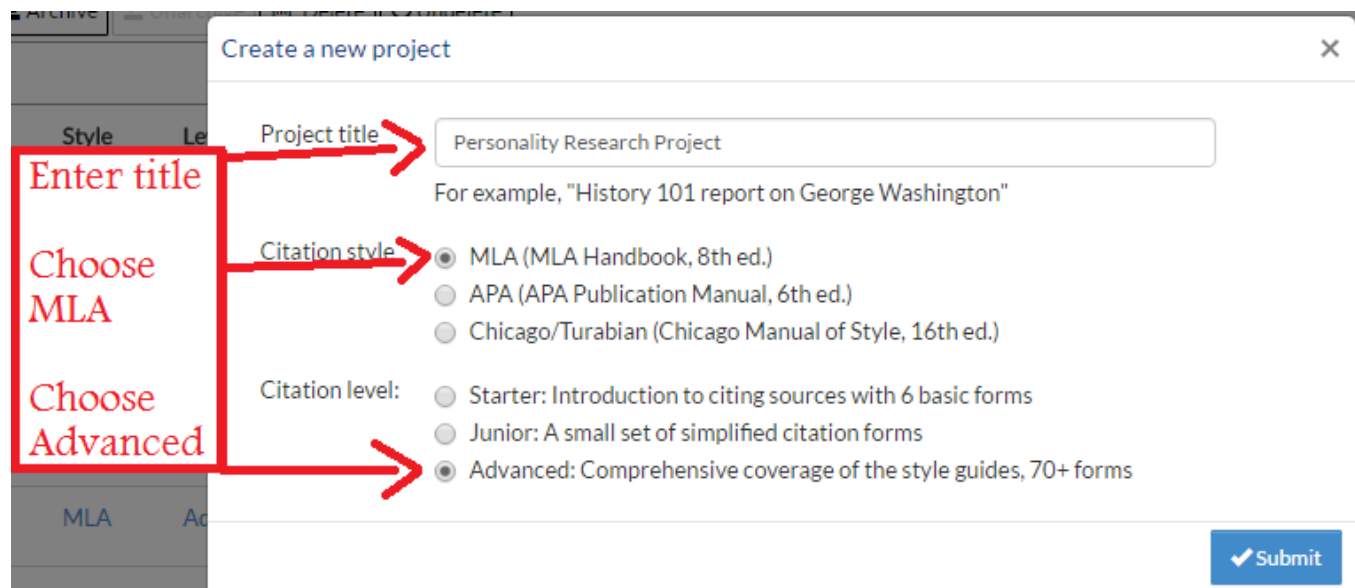

Creating a project in Noodletools

1. Login to Noodletools
2. Click the green button “new project.”



3. Title your project
4. Choose “MLA” for Citation Style (unless otherwise instructed by your teacher)
5. Choose “Advanced” for Citation Level.
6. Click “Submit.”



7. When the project opens you will see different links for your project.
 - a. “Dashboard” is the “homepage” for your project.
 - b. “Sources” is where you enter your citations.
