

Introduction Letter

The first step in the International Classroom Program is to write an introduction letter to the Danish students. This letter is the first impression your partner(s) will have of you, so keep that in mind.

Your letter should represent your personality – so no need to be overly formal! Please keep in mind that colloquialisms may not be as familiar, so try to avoid sayings or abbreviations.

Include ALL of the following information in your letter:

Technical Information

1. Your name (obviously)
2. Your gender preference for partner (If it doesn't matter, include that as well)
3. Any allergies/food restrictions/pet issues you have
4. Any other special issues you need to share
5. Describe your family
6. Share any pets you have in your home
7. ARE YOU ABLE TO HOST 2 DANES?

Personal Information

1. What are your hobbies and interests?
2. What activities do you participate in at school and out of school?
3. What kind of things are you looking forward to doing with your partner(s)?

Keep it light...this is not a job interview!

Please make sure these letters are complete and sent to BOTH Dr. and Mr. Morabito before Monday September 16 (so no later than Sunday at 11:59 PM)!
