

GVHS Math Department Retest Policy 2016-17

Revised 9/7/16

For Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra 2 (Academic A and Accelerated)

Students who receive a grade below 73% on any test (not quizzes) may elect to take a retest. The retest procedure is as follows:

1. To be eligible to retest, a student must have completed all the homework assigned for the given unit. The required homework should be corrected and shown to classroom teacher before the student receives the remediation materials.
2. The remediation assignment should be completed and given to the classroom teacher within one week of the day the test was returned to the student.
3. After the remediation assignment has been turned in and reviewed by the classroom teacher, the student must meet with the classroom teacher to schedule the retest. The classroom teacher may assign additional remediation work as needed to ensure that the student is adequately prepared for the retest.
4. The final test grade is the higher of (1) the original test grade or (2) the retest score capped at 73%. Thus, the highest possible replacement grade is 73%.
5. The retest must occur within two weeks of the date the original test was returned.
6. Academic A students may take a maximum of two retests per marking period. Accelerated students may take only one retest per marking period.
