DURING THE June 14, 2021 BOARD MEETING...

The business meeting was called to order by President David Barratt. Board members present: Jennifer Armstrong, Amy Chain, Stephen Dittmann, Rachel Gallegos, Samantha Jouin, Wendy Litzke, Neha Mehta and Bryan Paluch.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Mr. Barratt stated that there will be a business meeting of the Board on Monday, July 19 at 7:30 p.m. The public is invited to attend in person. While the meeting will also be streamed live on YouTube for remote viewing, public comment will only be taken in person by those in attendance.

Student Representative to the Board

Hope Semar thanked the Board and Administration for their work on behalf of the students. She also expressed thanks for their support in her role as Student Board Representative. She recognized **Ria Kokkengada**, the alternate student representative for the 2020-2021 school year. Hope then introduced **Meher Sachar** who will serve as Student Board Representative for the 2021-2022 school year and **Varunavi Raghuraman** who will serve as the alternate.

Presentations

Executive Session

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, **Mr. Barratt** stated that the board held an Executive Session prior to this meeting to discuss legal, personnel, and land issues, and that the board would be going back to Executive Session following the meeting to discuss personnel matters.

Secretary's Correspondence

Mr. Barratt asked **Mr. Peterson** if there was any Secretary's Correspondence. Mr. Peterson spoke in recognition of **Linda White**, who served as Board Secretary for many years, and will be retiring on June 30. Several board members expressed thanks for her service.

Chester County Intermediate Unit Board Report

Mr. Dittmann reported that he and Dr. Goffredo attended graduation ceremonies at Owen J. Roberts. Mr. Dittmann said that 7 graduates attending CAT Pickering are Great Valley students.

Legislative Report

Mrs. Litzke stated that the Legislative Council met on May 26. The Budget was reviewed with no updated news. The Council reviewed the bills that are before the House and Senate Education committees. Mrs. Litzke reported charter school reform was also a topic of discussion as well as SB1 and SB733. The next meeting is scheduled for June 23.

Council for Diversity and Inclusion

Mrs. Jouin stated that the CDI will reconvene in September.

The Great Valley School District Education Foundation

Mrs. Chain stated that Education Foundation would be meeting on Tuesday, June 15. She said that the Foundation is looking forward to fundraising and fund giving in the year ahead.

Superintendent's Report

David Schrader of Schrader Group Architecture gave an update on the Grade 5/6 Center. With assistance of **Chris Farmer**, Mr. Schrader provided a conceptual demonstration of the two-story structure, taking into consideration the requests of the township and the 5/6 Center Planning Committee. He concluded with an overview of the timeline for the project.

Mr. Peterson stated that according to the PA Act 39 and EPA Safe Drinking Water Act ([SDWA](#)), the board and community are required to be notified about lead in the drinking water. He reported that testing is performed on a regular basis and to date there has been no detection of lead. Recent water samples were tested on June 9th and the results should be back soon.

Dr. Goffredo began the [presentation](#) by sharing good news, events, and highlights around student and staff achievement. He then reported about recent guidance changes from the Chester County Health Department with regard to face coverings. He stated that the district will be developing a new Health and Safety Plan for 2021-2022. Discussion on this topic will take place at the July 19 board meeting. Dr. Goffredo reported that conversations are still underway with the GVEA about a virtual program for the next school year. Lastly, Dr. Goffredo spoke about staffing for next year. The board agreed to posting positions that Dr. Goffredo recommended.
