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During the May 23, 2022 Special Meeting ...

Public Comment on Agenda Items

Financial Approvals

The General Construction Contract with Lobar, Inc., with acceptance of alternate items GC-1, GC-3, GC-4, GC-6a, GC-7, GC-8, GC-9, and GC-12, at a cost of \$3,400,000, was approved by a vote of 9 to 0.

The board voted 9 to 0 to approve the Electrical Construction Contract base bid with Philips Brothers Electrical Contractors, Inc., accepting Options EC-2, EC-3, EC-5, EC-6, EC-7 and EC-8, for a total cost of \$8,916,000.

The Food Service Construction Contract with 11400, Inc., at a cost of \$1,116,000, was approved by a vote of 9 to 0.

The board voted 9 to 0 to approve the Fire Protection Construction Contract with Accelerated Fire Protection, Inc., at an amount totaling \$985,546 by a vote of 9 to 0.

The HVAC Construction Contract with North Bay Mechanical, LLC, at the cost of \$11,140,000, was approved by a vote of 9 to 0.

The board voted 9 to 0 to approve the Plumbing Construction Contract with JBM Mechanical, Inc., with the PC-1 Alternate, at a cost of \$2,277,000.

Financial Approvals

The board voted 9 to 0 to approve the proposal from Plymouth Environmental for asbestos remediation at 348 Swedesford Road at a total cost of \$19,000. The motion carried by a vote of 9 to 0.

The purchase of the building and property located at 100 Lindenwood Drive, Malvern, from BOF II PA Lindenwood, LLC, at a cost of \$3,400,000 was approved by a vote of 9 to 0.
