During the June 6, 2022 Special Meeting ...

The June 6, 2022, special business meeting was called to order by President David Barratt. **Board members present** were Tricia Chasinoff, Rachel Gallegos, Samantha Jouin, Neha Mehta, and Andrea Rizzo. **Joining via Zoom:** Jennifer Armstrong **Absent:** Stephen Dittmann, Wendy Litzke

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, **Mr. Barratt** announced that the board met in Executive Session prior to the meeting to discuss personnel and legal matters.

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Peterson gave an update on the 2022-2023 budget. He stated that the millage rate will be at 22.92 mills with a 2.5% increase from the prior year. This is below the allowed Act 1 Index of 3.4%. Mr. Peterson also reported that, for the first time in over a decade, the Homestead/Farmstead allocation from the state increased almost \$300,000.

Financial Approvals

The board voted 7 to 0 to approve the budget resolutions approving the 2022-2023 General Fund Budget and Capital Project Budget. The motion carried by a vote of 7 to 0.
